SAFE WORK METHOD STATEMENT

Brandition aims to protect persons from the hazards associated with onsite work.

A Code of Practice and Induction will be provided to all persons working for the Business and is governed by Safe Work Australia. The induction training will provide workers with an awareness and understanding of common hazards on most sites and how they should be managed. A summary is as follows:

DEVELOPMENT	A nationally recognized general induction program.	Site induction will be based on site safely or OHS management plan and may be provided in the form of information and instructions specific to a particular site.	Task-specific training will be based on safe work methods and may be provided in the form of information and instructions specific to a particular activity.
